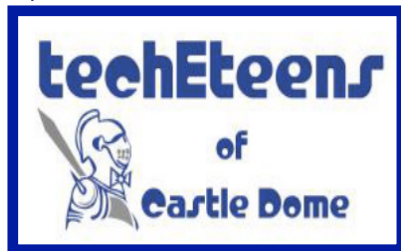




My name is Nathania. I am an honor role student at Castle Dome Middle School. I love to play soccer.

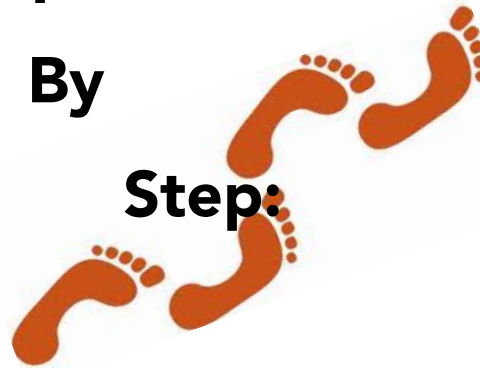
